Because He cares for those in need we are compelled to serve. We believe that small things done in great love will change the world!

Student Mission Trip

June 16-20 | Build A Home For A Family In Need

We will travel to Rocky Point, Mexico this summer to join the missionary work of One Mission by building a home, serving the community food and reaching out to a local orphanage.

This trip has been specifically designed for students, 7-12 grades. For every 20 students who go on this mission trip - one house is built.

This trip will be a physical and spiritual challenge for every member of our team. This is not a vacation, but rather a ministry designed to stretch your faith and allow God to use you to make an eternal difference in people whose lives are very different from your own.

Cost & Deposit Deadline

The cost per student is **\$295.00** and includes transportation, lodging, meals, international medical insurance coverage and construction materials.

By **Sunday, May 2nd**, we will need your completed Release of Liability form (included separately in this packet) along with your payment. You may return it to Joy Herring on any Sunday morning or by mailing it to the Journey Church Office at 9059 W. Lake Pleasant Parkway, Suite 401, Peoria, AZ 85382.

Support Raising Terms & Guidelines:

We will instruct you on how to raise support at our first training session. **If you are unable to raise the remaining \$145 you will be responsible for the balance, and if a balance occurs final payment will be due on Sunday, June 13th.**

Any funds raised over and above the \$145 sponsorship that each participant is responsible for will be included in a pool of Mexico mission dollars allowing Journey to finance additional projects for One Mission and will not go toward reducing the participant's \$150 obligation.

Cancellation Policy

If for any reason you are unable to participate in the trip, you will forfeit \$75.00 of your registration fee. Refunds for the remaining balance will be determined on a case by case basis.

Our Team

Our student mission trip will be led by Brandon Grieser who will be heading up a team of adults to facilitate this life changing weekend. This team of people would not only look out for the safety of the students, but also help stretch and challenge them practically and spiritually.

Training Meetings

Our first training meeting will be held on Sunday, April 11th at the Journey Church Office at 9059 W. Lake Pleasant Parkway, Suite 401, Peoria, AZ 85382 at 1 pm. Details on other training meetings are listed on page 9.

Transportation & Lodging

We will depart from the Journey Church Office at 12 pm on Wednesday, June 16th and return to the Journey Church Office on Sunday, June 20th at 6 pm. We will be providing transportation and will be staying at the One Mission Base Camp.

Immunizations

Mexico does not require any immunizations for entry. However, please visit the CDC's website www.cdc.gov/travel for more information regarding immunizations. Please discuss your travel plans and personal health with your physician to determine which vaccines you will need. These

vaccinations should be done at least 4-5 weeks prior to travel.

Passport Required!

A valid passport (card or book) is required for your travel with Journey Church to Mexico. If you already have your passport you are ahead of the game.

The laws for passports have continued to change over the past year, and therefore the demand for passports is very high. So, if you do not have your passport, please start the application process right away so that you will receive your passport in time for the trip.

Please Note: A passport (card or book) is MANDATORY to travel with Journey Church! NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!

You will need your passport or passport card.

What Do We Need To Bring?

- Sleeping bag, blanket, and pillow
- Toiletries: soap, shampoo, deodorant, towel, etc.
- Sandals (shower)
- Flashlight
- Camp Chair
- Sturdy water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Appropriate Swim Suit for optional outdoor showers & swimming pool.
- Work clothes (NO dresses, shorts, Capri's, or tank tops)
- Work Shoes/boots – No open toes on worksites
- Work Gloves
- Warm Clothes – Evenings & Mornings get Cold
- Rain gear

What Should We Wear?

We strictly adhere to the following clothing guidelines:

Rear Views: Writing or design on the rear of shorts and pants is inappropriate. Low riding or baggy shorts or pants is also inappropriate.

Fit: Tight fitting shirts, tops and pants are inappropriate. If the participant's definition of appropriate or modest differs from that of Journey Church and/or One Mission's, the participant will be asked to change.

Should I Bring Extra Money?

Yes. We will be stopping on the way to and on the way back from Mexico for a meal (approx. \$20).

Prayer

Our team will rely heavily on prayer in a variety of areas including trip finances, the mission field, and each team member's personal growth. Please make a personal commitment to pray for yourself, your teammates, and the people we will be serving in Mexico. We will talk more about this during our training sessions.

Ways to Give

There are three ways that someone can give to the Mexico Mission Trip... through the offering, mail or our website. Journey Church is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization so any gift/donation received for the Mexico Mission Trip is tax-deductible.

Through the Offering

If they are at one of our services on Sunday they can give through the offering envelope. Simply put the dollar amount on the Missions line and write the name of the individual they are supporting on the "Other" line.

For them to use the envelope they need to put the amount of their donation on the "Missions" line and write the name of the individual they are supporting on the "Other" line.
